EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of the Interior and Local Government Region 1 (DILG R1) continues to provide the needed technical assistance to the 129 Local Government Units (LGUs) of the Region in the implementation of the major deliverables of the Department for CY 2017.

Notable accomplishments include heightened awareness on peace and order programs; enhanced capacities and compliance of LGUs to laws and issuances; hastened implementation of the locally-funded projects through the conduct of validation visits, and quarterly evaluation.

The impact of the DILG R1 Team is reflected in the number of LGUs which demonstrate seamless performance. For three consecutive years, Region 1 continues to have the most number of SGLG awardees.

Regional initiatives were also implemented which include the training on Mainstreaming DRR-CCA in CDP using the CDRA Tool for Non-Major River Basin (Non-MRB) LGUs and conduct of Local Legislation 101, Plus, Plus.



125 LGUs participated in the MASA MASID program roll-out on January 23-24, January 26-27, January 30-February 1, and February 2-3, in Pangasinan, La Union, Ilocos Sur, and Ilocos Norte, respectively





Coaches Training on the Strengthening of MASA MASID teams, conducted on September 25 (Ilocos Norte), September 26 (Ilocos Sur), September 22 (La Union), and September 19- 20 (Pangasinan)



100% or 3,265 barangays have organized MASA MASID Teams

125 C/MLGOOs, with 33 Regional / Community Facilitators trained on Information and Intelligence gathering (Training on Feedback Mechanism) conducted on November 29 - December 1 at One Vittoria Hotel, Bantay, Ilocos Sur

Barangay Assembly Day (BAD)

or 3,265 barangays in Region 1 conducted Barangay Assembly Day in March and October 2017. Pantal, Dagupan City, and Pandan, Bacnotan, La Union were the showcase barangays for the 1st Semester and 2nd Semester Barangay Assembly Day, respectively.



Comprehensive Local Integration Program (CLIP)

In an effort of the government to attain a lasting peace in the country, 12 Former Rebels who were members of the New People's Army, received financial assistance through the Comprehensive Local Integration Program (CLIP) of the government. Out of 12, six (6) surrendered their guns and given

corresponding firearm remuneration. Two (2) Governors, namely: Ilocos Sur Governor Ryan Luis V. Singson and La Union Governor Francisco Emmanuel "Pacoy" R. Ortega III, heads of their respective Provincial CLIP Committees, played an important role in providing psycho-social and socio-economic security to the former rebels to help them become productive members of the society. The DILG spearheaded the review of documentary requirements of former rebels and the issuance of financial assistance.

Sustaining the Effectiveness of Sub-National POCs



The Regional Peace and Order Council (RPOC) quarterly meetings were conducted on March 22 at Plaza del Norte Hotel and Convention Center, Laoag City, Ilocos Norte; July 20 at the Diego Silang Hall, La Union Provincial Capitol, City of San Fernando, La Union; September 28 at Sison Auditorium, Lingayen, Pangasinan; and December 6 at Baluarte, Vigan City, Ilocos Sur.

The provincial roll-out on Peace and Order and Public Safety Plan (POPSP) Policy Compliance Monitoring System (PCMS) were conducted on September 11, 12, 18, and 19 in Pangasinan, La Union, Ilocos Norte, and Ilocos Sur, respectively.

100% or 129 LGUs – four (4) Provinces, nine (9) Cities, and 116 Municipalities have approved POPSP.

Strengthening the Capabilities of the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB)





The DILG Region 1 conducted seven (7) batches of Strengthening the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) on October 17 - November 10 in the provinces of Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union and Pangasinan. All nine (9) Cities and 116 Municipalities were covered in the activity.

Full Disclosure Policy (FDP)

Region 1 LGUs – 4 Provinces, 9 Cities, 116 Municipalities and 3,265 barangays have been consistently complying to the FDP 1st to 4th quarter posting requirements.



Local Development Council (LDC)

The Regional Strategic Workshop was conducted on August 17-18 at the Oasis Country Resort Hotel, La Union.

Following the regional workshop was the Provincial Strategic Direction Setting Conference Workshop conducted in the four (4) provinces - August 30-31 in Ilocos Norte, August 24-25 in Ilocos Sur, August 29-30 in La Union, and August 23-24 in Pangasinan.

Participatory Prioritization Conference Workshops were conducted in all the 116 municipalities from August 29 to September 6.

As a result, 100% of the municipalities in Region 1 have reviewed and validated Local Development and Investment Plans (LDIP).

Brgy. 1 San Lorenzo was again declared as the Outstanding Barangay Lupon and received a Hall of Fame Award for bagging the LTIA National Award on the Component Cities Category, for three consecutive years (2015, 2016 and 2017).



Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG)



Among the **17 regions** nationwide, **Region 1** again registered the **MOST NUMBER OF AWARDEES** in the **Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG)** for **2017**, significantly surpassing its 45 LGU passers last year.

The **68 LGU- awardees** represent **53%** of the **129** total number of LGUs assessed in Region 1, and a **51%** increase from the **45 LGU** passers in 2016.
